Remote Learning Information for Parents

Accessing Remote Education

All lesson information will be shared directly via email and information will be provided by your child's teacher on the format being used for specific year groups.

Teachers will provide:

- Daily English lessons/activities - set for each class
- Daily maths lessons/activities - set for each class
- Weekly RE lesson.
- Foundation subject lesson ideas and activities.
- Weekly PE lesson activities

Our approach includes using a blend of paper-based and online learning, including some virtual face-to-face sessions through MS Teams and resources available through online learning platforms such as (although not limited to):

Curriculum

We teach the same curriculum remotely as we do in school wherever possible and appropriate. However, we have needed to make some adaptations in some subjects. Lessons such as Art, Music and Science may require specific equipment, for example.

Remote Teaching and study time each day

We expect that remote education (including remote teaching and independent work) will take pupils the following number of hours each day:

KS1 3 hours

KS2 4 hours

Microsoft TEAMS

Teachers will hold regular face to face sessions using Microsoft Teams to support online learning. These will be for a year group or class of pupils. To access these meetings your child will need to use their individual school email address:

An invitation to join a meeting will be sent along with detailed instructions on how to join a TEAMS meeting before each session.

How we can help your child to access online learning

Some families may not have suitable online access at home. We have a small number of laptops that can be loaned out to pupils who have limited access to devices. Contact the school office office@kilby.leics.sch.uk to register your interest in loaning a laptop and to find out more.

Some families may require paper copies of work and we can post these out. Contact the office to request this service.

Engagement and Feedback

Class Teachers will contact families by phone each week to provide support and advice on learning at home. This enables us to ensure children are successfully engaging in the work set.

Pupils are encouraged to email examples of their work in Maths, English and one other subject each week. On receipt of these, teachers will provide regular feedback, usually within 48 hours.

Assessments such as quizzes will be used regularly to review pupils' progress and achievement.

Pupils with Additional Needs

We recognise that some of our pupils may struggle to access remote learning without adult support. Teachers will continue to plan for pupils who have additional needs by differentiating the work set and providing additional or alternative resources.
